

Introduction

Jeshua affirms again our power of choice and creativity. I love the explanation that he gives us about the usefulness of *time* in slowing down the consequences of our impulsive thoughts or actions. We have all probably had cause to be relieved, that we had the time to reconsider a decision: “Maybe I want to rethink this”. He also connects “the gift of patience” with our experience of time.

Jeshua gives us all an incredible blessing in his assurance that everything that we have chosen is “leading us to the awakening that we so desire. You never make a wrong choice. Everything that you choose leads you to the next step that in time leads you to the place where there is no time.” With no possibility of making a wrong choice, there comes tremendous freedom of expression and expansion. “A joyful future!”

Another big idea in this chapter is that “You cannot give your power away, because it is you. Your power is your divine Is-ness, and it is leading you Home. So be happy in that. Know that truly you are coming Home.”

Jeshua beautifully tells us about prayer as “speaking to that divine Self, the inner Self within. Use prayer for clarification.” Meditation is then the act of listening to the answers, being still. “Make the visioning come from the highest and best for all concerned.”

The power principles of “The Master SECRET”:

- We have designed the concept of time to give us space to contemplate some of our decisions, that could take us to “a place where you do not really want to be”.
- All of our choices have lead us to this time in our lives where we are right now, “accepting your power”.
- We can’t give away our power, because our power is our divine being.
- We have truly never left Home, because we carry it within us.
- Pray, be still, meditate and hear the Voice within.
- “Every stage of life presents you with opportunities.”
- “Whatever you decree, it will be as reality to you. You are making your reality moment by moment.”

Discussion Questions

- What passage in this chapter touches your heart? Your mind? Your imagination? Changes how you understand yourself and your life?
- Have you had that feeling about Home that Jeshua describes on page 146 (not feeling like you are Home in this life)? Have you come to the realization that “You have truly never left Home. You cannot. It is within you, and you can never leave Home.” Talk to your partner about this concept and what your experience has been and what is your understanding now.
- Jeshua tells us that “You do not need *someone else* to pray for you. You do need to *pray for yourself*. You do need to recognize the inner Self, the divine Self, and to speak with that divine Self often”. What is your relationship with prayer and this perspective (read page 147) in how to pray?

Assignments

- Have you ever had a chance to be grateful for *time*, as a stalling effect to some impulse that you had? Give an example of when you reversed your decision because you had the time to reconsider. Have these kind of experiences helped you to be more patient with yourself? Consider something that you are struggling with now that perhaps could benefit from patience and re-consideration. Meditate about it and note any insights that you receive from the time you spend with it.
- If you have not experienced prayer in the way that Jeshua describes it “speaking with the inner Self and visioning from the highest and best for all concerned” (also known as affirmative prayer), give it a try. Use meditation as a time for being still and listening to the Voice within. Breathe in Peace.
- “Every stage of life presents you with opportunities.” Consider what opportunities are in your life, in whatever stage you are in. Now see yourself from the perspective of your divine Self, your expanded Self. Record your opportunities from this perspective and end them with the statement “Whatever I decree, will be my reality.” Notice what opportunities you create for yourself and how your divine Self rushes in to assist you. Make notes of gratitude!
- **Affirmations for the Week:**
 - I always abide in the eternal Now and the eternal peace of the Now.
 - Home is always within me. I trust my divine Self!
 - Everything that I have chosen is leading me to the Awakening.
