

Introduction by Rev. Don Knight

In just two pages, Rev Don Knight manages to capture the essence of what is to come in this seventh volume of Jeshua’s “mind-sparkling perspectives” which lead us back to our Divine Nature. He stresses that these teachings are practical and are meant to bring us to peace and love.

He also goes into the meaning of Oakbridge University as a perfect metaphor for the organization that was created in 1989 to provide the structure under which these teachings could be disseminated.

I was part of the discussion that chose the name for several reasons. One of them is the one that Don examines “from tiny acorns, mighty oaks grow” eloquently. We are tasked with taking those nuggets of Truth and growing them in our lives until we are living them in accordance with our Divine Nature.

Another metaphor that Judi, Tom Coates and I explored was that Oak was an ancient name for God (as when God was recognized as residing in all beings and a grove of Oak trees was a sacred meeting place in which to attune to that vibrational energy). And the bridge part of the name is meant to remind us that we are the “bridge people”. We are meant to remember our divine heritage and be the way-showers for all our brothers and sisters to find their way back to their highest “God-self” goodness, Love and Joy.

Jeshua has told us that the seeds of this mighty Oak have been deeply planted in the rich soil of our consciousness and that “in time” they will grow strong and bear much spiritual fruit. Oakbridge University is the support structure that now holds these books (and recordings) and the community of the Heart Family.

Rev. Don Knight was a devoted disciple of Jeshua’s teachings. He wrote several books in which he shared his wisdom and the understanding that he had gained from Jeshua and his own Unity ministry over the years. He was a close associate of Judi and Tom Coates, spending his last years in the same household.

Learning Institute, which he wrote under the name of Uno, and later under the name Seven Arrows, which he felt Spirit had given him. He served on the Oakbridge University Board of Directors for several years as well.

“You have written all the chapters of your life, for you are an Institute of SELF Learning. All of your learning is valuable. Each and every part of your learning is what is now leading you to the One SELF of Whom you are. It took a long time to write the chapters of your Book of Life, so it will take some time to re-examine all those chapters for their usefulness and clarity. It is good to abandon any idea of instant Nirvana. Instead, know that we do receive degrees of enlightenment that spur us on in our upward way to higher and higher consciousness. Remember, you are endowed with the Patience of God, for you live in God’s eternal time, thus you can persevere with a diligence in exploring your Book of Life without anxiety. Know your Self to be the way Home.”
