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with no judgment, no judgment of self, no judgment of others. Because, in truth, life is an expression of the Light. But it is not a competitive of having to be a brighter light, or a smarter light or a more turned-on light. There is not a competition.

So, as he would sit by flowing water and come to a place of peace, there would be an understanding that everyone who expresses in this physical form has talents and abilities, each one individualized in their own way. Each one beautiful, each

one expressing the God self. But there were times that I had to remind him of this.

He worked with me in the

carpentry shop that we had. He helped build some of the tables and chairs and stools that ones would sit on. He could get the legs of the stool in the right place so that when one would sit on it, you did not fall over. There is a bit of technique there. It took a couple of tries for him to know the balance of where the legs would go. Same thing with a table as to get it so that it would not rock back and forth: Get the legs at the same height. So there was a bit of learning of technique, and of measurement, as well. He was a very quick study.

But there were times when his tables went a little strange and needed a bit of the equalizing underneath. We had a couple of times — we had the table that started out at arm's length, and ended up being a bit smaller table,

but that was that was okay. It was a learning experience.

And yes, he did know a few choice expressions, which he used from time to time. He would not — well, he might tell you that...— *I* will tell you that! But yes, he helped me in the carpentry shop,


and learned how to put together the wood and how to speak with the wood, how to sit with a piece of wood and ask of it, "What do you want to be when you grow up? What do you want to be?" Especially with the ones that we carved, because some of the tables and the chairs that we made, were not just of useful appearance, but they were beautiful works of art, because we did some of the carving across the back or around the sides of the table as well.



I have shared with you in previous times how you can go to the place of Oneness and you ask of the wood lovely tree that it was before the wood - "How do you want to be fashioned?" And the most wonderful language is the imagery that happens within the mind. Because as you will sit and contemplate and ask and then be silent, the wood will speak to you. And you will see, within what is called the mind's eye, you will see how the carving can be. Whether it is just straight up and down or whether it has the curls into it or whether it will go a round a corner etc.

When this first happens, it is most amazing. You know this from some of the plantings that you do. You know this from some of the trees that you have hugged and there has been a knowing of oneness as the tree is growing. Oftentimes you have seen me when I have come and visited with you, you have seen me go and feel the wood and to feel whether it is happy or not.

Everything is vibration. And so when you sit upon the chair, it is going to absorb the temporary, at least passing, energy. Everything, in truth, is alive. Even if you say "Well, the poor tree is dead. It's been chopped up," etc. No, it is still vibrating. It is vibrating. Then when you sit and you put your energy into it, after you get up — you have had other ones tell you this — you leave a certain imprint of your vibrational energy sitting there.



So, it behooves you to be happy. It is okay if it is temporarily a thing you are working through. The wood does not hold grievances; does not hold judgment. Vibration, yes, it holds. And then the humans come along and interpret as I have just done. but in truth the wood has the vibration. I have given to you my interpretation of it.

But the point that I am making is, Everything is alive. And if you sit quietly with anything, it will tell you a story. So try that on your morrow, when you get up and you are going through your morning meditation



allow yourself to perhaps feel the bed stead, the form of the bed, and ask of it, "How was the previous night's sleep?" It will tell you. It will say "Well, he was really restless and he tossed and turned and I thought..." It will tell you a story—many stories.

What is important is to come to that place of knowing the Reality, capital "R," of every living thing and

that everything truly is alive; it vibrates. It is alive. To come to that place of melding your knowing with the knowing of what seems to be already finished, dead and gone. It is not ever! It may not move much, but it does vibrate. All of the crystalline energy that is so beautiful has great vibration.

Each crystal, different types, different formations, have their own language. And you can feel it. And you can interpret it, which you have done several lifetimes where you have been the ... what do they call the...the gemologists? —We will make up a new word. Most wondrous, the way they capture the light and shine your light back at you. You have a saying like that, "back at you." That is what the crystals do. They reflect back to You that which you are — the Light that

you are.

Ask what the crystal will share with you. Be quiet and just breathe; breathe the energy of the crystal. And it will tell you. It will give you a picture imagery of where it has come from. How it is interpreting the energy that it is.

Everything that you have created is alive. "Wow. Well, I can see that brothers and sisters, they're alive. I can see the four-footed ones, they're alive. I see the winged ones, they're definitely alive. But you say that the chair is alive?" Yes, your technology has come to a place where the vibrational frequency of something that seems to be solid can be measured. Same thing with crystals. Same thing with everything that is seemingly inanimate.

The same thing for me when I was a small one. I would pick up a rock or I would see the trees and I would think, "Oh that's a beautiful tree out there: The way it is moving and swaying with a breeze..." Then I went closer to it (I like to climb trees get a beautiful view) The tree spoke to me. What the first one said to me was "Take your dirty foot off of me!" (Smile) It did not stop me from climbing trees. It did not stop me from taking the wood that was already cut and making it into a beautiful object.

Know you that you can take a part of the trunk of a tree, and you can carve the outside and round it a bit at the bottom and you can carve out the inside. And if you are very good you can carve a certain handle on the side. It takes a bit of practice.

The first few handles I did fell off....



The same for all of you as you work with something within your home. If you take the time for it — I have noticed that sometimes you rush through the "daily chores" — allow yourself to slow down. To be in tune to feel the vibration of the furniture. Now, I know sometimes when you get tired, you just plop. Okay. but after you have rested, for a short time, begin to feel "What's the message?" as you are sitting there. Because every part of your body has receptors. So, if you have the rear, sitting somewhere, be in tune. Ask of the chair that you are sitting on, "Who is the last person who sat on this chair and what were they like? Were they happy?" And the chair may say to you "It's none of your business." (Smile)

Yes, there is a language, a universal language that is understood in sensitivity. That is my message: to be happy with your surroundings, to be at one with your surroundings. Know that truly everything that you create has a life of its own. And a language which will speak to you. A person said to me when I was small, and becoming quite enamored with the vibration of wood, "How can you be caring about something that is dead? It was cut a long time ago." And I said, "But if you listen, if you're really asking of it and truly wanting to know, there will be a message in it for you."

Do not rush through life. That is my message to you. When you are working with the certain texture of cloth, it will speak to you it will tell you where to cut and where not to cut. It will tell you how it wants to be fashioned. There is a certain sensitivity that you develop, perhaps not right away, but as there will be desire.

I do like that word and I will go off on a tangent here for half a minute. "Desire" is of the Father: D-e, "of", s-i-r-e "the father" — "of the father."

So, that is my message to you. I appreciate your attention. I appreciate your allowing me to speak. Because one earthly father of Yeshúa does not often get a chance to speak. OK no I am what you would call an "also mentioned" in the Bible. When they run their credits I am an "also mentioned." But I would have you know that every fertilization — I guess you can call it — is divine. And yes, I was earthly father to one Yeshúa. I know you have stories that say that it was virgin birth. I knew Mary, Mother Mary as you call her. Loved her and still do very greatly. And yes, we joined and yes, Yeshúa came forth. Your holy book writes me out. (Smile)
