

## Introduction

Jeshua has an intriguing way of introducing the dimensions, by saying that “When we moved from some of the other star constellations, **when we moved our consciousness** to an incarnation upon this planet, this reality, we created the sun, in order to live, move, play upon the firmament.”

I have questions about this: How does **consciousness** move, if it supposedly exists everywhere? Are there places where consciousness is not? Is it dependent on a dimension?

In this chapter Jeshua tells us that the common expression of “being on Cloud Nine” is actually our metaphor for “looking at everything from above, from the highest point of view.” This is the “energy of Intelligence Itself, which moves you into the higher levels of joy. There is a feeling of joy which cannot be contained, a feeling of wanting to be in service. That is where the masters abide, 10<sup>th</sup> dimension and above.”

Of course, these levels and gradations are only concepts that our human minds like to play with and not something that we should get stuck on. The important message is that “Wherever you find yourself- in any dimension, level, reality – always you are Home. **Every dimension, every level contains the essence of Home – because you are.**”

Accepting our multi-dimensionality and remembering our Christ consciousness is truly most important for our awakening to our divinity and living as the masters that we are.

## Discussion Questions

### Affirmation for the Week:

**“I am always Home, because I contain the essence of Home.”**

- What passage in this chapter touches your heart? Your mind? Your imagination?
- Jeshua tells us that even though we “walk temporarily with the cloak of forgetfulness” there is the still, small Voice that keeps “nudging you: **Remember Who you are. Remember Who you are.**” Have you had this nudging experience and what did you make of it? Have you followed the recommendations of that Voice?
- Jeshua states that we move back and forth between dimensions, especially the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>. Think of an example of this kind of shifting that has or is happening in your life. When are you securely living in the 5 dimension? Is it dependent on the issues that you are dealing with in your life? Jeshua describes it thus: “when you abide for a while in the 5<sup>th</sup> dimension, what happens is an expansion. It is the most awesome place to be. It is a place of love, a place where you behold, and you begin to take hold of the realization of the Christ, that Divine Self of you, Which creates.”
- Do you **truly know** that “always you are Home”? What does that mean to you?

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## Assignments

1. Look up the various definitions of “firmament”, both common and biblical. Is it in the atmosphere surrounding our earth or does it refer to expansiveness? Does it give you any clues about where consciousness is capable of existing? Reread the creation story of Genesis and substitute your Higher Self for the word God. How does this affect your understanding or feeling of this story? Do you have any soul memory of being there as part of the Oneness/God creating the earth?
2. Jeshua reminds us that the belief in separation causes the ego to judge others and self as less than perfect. However, whatever the Holy Child (that’s you and me) creates “has to be perfect”. What do you judge as being less than perfect in your life? Practice expanding to the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> dimension and finding the perfection in what you have created.
3. Daily affirmation: “I am always Home. I contain the essence of Home.”
