Introduction

Jeshua takes on a core belief that we have all been taught. He dispels the idea of God or Jeshua as being a “Savior”, outside of ourselves, who has magic powers. He also empathizes with the phase of disillusionment, confusion and loneliness that many experience upon learning that Jeshua “cannot save you.”

On the other hand how incredibly empowering it is to know that there is no separation from the power that creates constellations, galaxies and even our holy Mother Earth! “In the beginning, before the descent into the point of focus of density, you knew yourself to be God.”

Jeshua outlines some steps in our process of reclaiming our Divine nature:

1. Realization that there is no Savior outside of you.
2. A period of adjustment to the idea of Oneness.
3. Praying to various masters, guides, angels and realizing that they are all aspects of Self.
4. Expanding the image of yourself as a point of the soul group from lower case “s” to the capital “S”.
5. Understanding “that the personal relationship with God is always there.”
6. Breathe and allow.

Another powerful and freeing statement is “The God that would be judgmental does not exist.” What a relief!
“Everything is You. You are an extension of the one Creator.”

Discussion Questions

- What passage in this chapter touches your heart? Your mind? Your imagination?
- Did you experience a period of disillusion or sadness “I am all alone here. If there is no God out there somewhere to save me, if there is no Jeshua to save, how am I ever going to be saved?” If you experienced that period how did you turn that around for yourself?
- Jeshua warns us that during our times of expansion and changes there will be upheaval, such as happens with a new crop is planted and the land is tilled, so we expect times of shifting and reorganizing our lives. Have you experienced these kinds of times of disorientations? What did you learn? Would you call it “expansion” of your consciousness?
- Do you **truly know** that you have a personal relationship with God that does not require extraordinary effort?

Assignments

1. Jeshua reminds us that “You have that written in your Scriptures even in this day ‘Ye are gods. You are gods.’ Have you heard that before? In what context are these words said? Look it up and explain your understanding of it.
2. Towards the end of the chapter, Jeshua brings up String Theory or sparks of energy. What does it have to do with the subject of this chapter – Personal Relationship with God? Research (google) String Theory and put together the information on how it relates to Oneness and Creation and even multiple dimensions.
3. Daily affirmation “I am Divine and as an extension of the one Creator I expand the Light.”
