
Chapter 15 - Trust: Living the Simple Life

Introduction

The operative word in this chapter is TRUST. When we can step into trust, it brings us peace as Jeshua assures us that “everything fits into the divine plan of At-one-ment”.

He tells us that as we trust, we move into a willingness to know our power and to choose to live the simple life that includes a sense of mindfulness, of living in each moment that we are creating. “You are divine. You are the creative Principle in action. Therefore, how could you not be taken care of? How could you not be loved?”

Always he exudes LOVE in his discourses with us, assuring us of our worthiness, our creativity and that we have been the ones who have “devised a plan for each lifetime...and for the collective consciousness. You are part of a vast web of consciousness”. Now that is something to contemplate.

Since we live in times of upheaval and we are experiencing much stress in our lives, this message is especially powerful as he tells us not to worry so much, because we are always taken care of and so very much loved. So it all comes back to trust and our willingness to breathe and choose to see things differently from what the world would have us believe. And then live the simple life “the joy of just being, knowing that always I am taken care of.”

With his wonderful sense of humor he teases us to recognize that “as you create the valley, so you create the mountains. As you create what seems to be troublesome, you also create the solutions.”

Assignments
