

Introduction

What a compelling way Jeshua has of engaging us in understanding our Divine nature and our connection with Abba – “our Source, the Loving Point of Creation”! His translation of that Hebrew word, gives us an even deeper reason to accept ourselves as the Divine Child, an extension of Abba.

He explains to us so clearly why we have this need to “worship” those who we think are above us in some way. It “comes from that deep inner desire to know your Allness, to know your Source, to know and realize your true Being.”

Jeshua redirects our understanding of this pull to “worship” of celebrities or even himself on a pedestal, into “worthship”, knowing our own worth, our Christ nature and that of every other being and life form on this plane. He uses that analogy of the magnetic energy as the beautiful attraction of God’s Love for us and ours for our Abba.

True worship is to be in “the place where there is great, great awe and celebration. All other worship is as vain ritual.”

Following up on the message in the previous chapter on living the Simple Life, in this chapter, Jeshua affirms that to live a life as an extension (Child) of Abba “Your life becomes a daily activity of worship”.



Discussion Questions

- What passage in this chapter touches your heart? Your mind? Your imagination?
- What or who have you worshiped in various stages of your life? It could be a teacher or philosophy or even a job, perhaps one that gave you a sense of worthiness? Worship also implies giving your power away to the object of your worship. How has that dynamic affected your life?
- Can you imagine living in “great, great awe and celebration”?

Assignments

1. Jeshua recommends that your “life becomes a daily activity of worship; not having to go down on the knees and to worship in that way, but beholding the Christ in everyone”. Become mindful in each day how you treat others in your life and up your level of treating them as the Divine Child of Abba that they are.
2. Also become more mindful in each day to treat yourself and your life with great great awe and celebration. “True worship then becomes a way of life, an ongoing understanding of true worth.”
3. This is a real challenge: “When next you behold or think about your celebrities, your presidents and your leaders, behold the Christ of them. You may or may not agree with their choices or behaviors, but you can and must agree with knowing the Christ at work. Everything serves the Atonement – patience and Love, especially.” Take a different person each day and practice seeing the Christ of them, no matter if you respect them and their actions or not. Journal about seeing these persons and their impact on personal/local/world events from this perspective and describe how that understanding affects you.
4. Daily affirmation “I am the beloved and wonderful Child of Abba.”
