

Introduction

Prophecies are an intriguing concept, because we are curious about our future. However, the important take-away from this interesting chapter is “that which you expect has power, power to manifest.” This theme of manifesting what we focus on and envision takes on additional meaning in this chapter.

Jeshua also encourages us to think and decide for ourselves and not get drawn into other people’s expectations or stories. “As long as you draw breath, you are in a place of unlimited possibilities. Let no one tell you what your truth has to be, because you are the maker of your truth moment by moment. So you can make your life anything you want it to be, anyhow you want it to be. Why would you not want to perceive it as good?”

He does affirm that we are at the end of a cycle of great density, the “Dark Ages” and are once again moving towards remembering our divinity. We are back on the path to dreaming big dreams and sharing with others “the excitement of possibilities”.

The power principles of Prophecies are:

- **Acknowledge End of a Cycle.** We are awakening from density of mere survival.
- **Question the assumptions of the world.**
- **Think for yourself and listen to your Heart.**
- **Embrace your divinity and “unlimitedness”.**
- **Claim your power.**
- **Dream big Dreams.**
- **Get excited about your creative abilities.**
- **Celebrate and share with others the excitement of possibilities.**

Discussion Questions

- What passage in this chapter touches your heart? Your mind? Your imagination?
- Where were you in 2012? What were your expectations about all the prophecies? Have you seen “the progression of challenges for humankind and also the progression of understanding that the challenges are not so much negative as they are gifts?” Give some examples of these shifts in your life since 2012.
- The world speaks to us most of lack and limitation. Can you imagine what the world would be like if instead of envying or competing with one another, we were happy to see everyone be in good health, be successful and loved? How does that feel to you?

Assignments

- Have you experienced the “Dark Ages” in your lifetime! (“You have done the suffering already. You have been there, done that. I have been there, done a bit of it, finished with it, completed – as you can be and as you are: complete.”) Have you turned the “dark times” into gifts as Jeshua suggests that we do? If not think about all that has happened to you and through you since 2012 and begin to turn the suffering into strengths. Do so by noticing what you want to transform in your life and call it “good”. Write in your journal or share with trusted friend.
- Get excited about a dream or desire that you have. “When you are in the place of excitement, you have an opening of energy. You are open to receiving help, assistance from the higher realms. And then what you are planning to do is given more impetus to move forward.” Take an action, however, small each day towards that dream and feel the excitement as your manifestation draws the energy of creation to it.
