

Introduction

It isn't often (if ever) that we get to consider ourselves as visionaries. But Jeshua's words activate this power within us, as we understand that being a visionary begins with the “visualization” of each day and the choices that we make where to focus our energy. This power gives us the opportunity to re-imagine our lives, change habits and see everything anew.

A hopeful message in this chapter is that humankind has “descended into density as far as you will ever go, and you are very much on your way back up, ascending; sometimes with a great leap of faith, other times a smaller step, but always changing and ascending.” He also tells us that when people take “pleasure in being divisive” they are temporarily halting their own ascension.

We are asked to visualize what intangibles we will take with us past this lifetime and then to live our lives accordingly – serving the Christ self.

The power principles of “Visionaries” are:

- **Look for the Good.**
- **Give Forgiveness to ones you would judge.**
- **Remember you have done things in the past that need forgiveness as well.**
- **Practice positive visualization. See world consciousness awakening, ascending in divine awareness.**
- **Focus on the intangibles, especially your Self Worth.**
- **Live in the space of Love and expansion.**
- **Appreciate the uniqueness of each person and their talents.**
- **Consciously participate in the ascension of the collective consciousness of humankind.**
- **Choose to serve the Christ, the true Self.**

Discussion Questions

- What passage in this chapter touches your heart? Your mind? Your imagination?
- Jeshua gives us a technique to switch off our “judgement” of others, with a realization that we have also done similar things “been there, done that” and then “very quickly think of that which you love and how that feels. That energy goes out and expands and touches other ones, and may make a difference in the choices they make.” Have you ever thought about how your energy affects those around you? How does this aid the process of ascension?
- What do you think of Jeshua’s description of death as a “great reunion, a remembrance of Oneness”?

Assignments

- Jeshua gives us an assignment: “this is your assignment, should you choose to accept it, and I will help you. Go deep within yourself and ask, ‘What is most important to me?’ When I get to the place of releasing the body and I look back on this incarnation, what is going to be most important to me? What can you take with you out of an incarnation? Ponder that for a while, because the tangible things stay here.” It will help you reprioritize where you focus your energy. Journal your new priorities.
- Jeshua outlines several techniques for dealing with the separated ego that want us to focus on fear. Practice them. They are:
 1. Acknowledge the ego with forgiveness. (page 160)
 2. If the ego doesn’t want change, assure the ego that changes will bring about ascension, which is good. (page 158)
 3. If ego runs in first when visualizing your day, reply with “Okay, I know your story. I want a new story.” (page 159)
- **Affirmation: “I choose this day to serve the Christ, the true Self.”**
