
Chapter 8 What are you Waiting For?

Introduction

I clearly remember the powerful energy with which Jeshua spoke to us on the night when he demanded of us “**What are you waiting for!?**” It felt like he was trying to shake us up out of complacency of waiting for permission from someone, to get on with making the choices for happiness, for our desires and for more love and fulfillment in our lives. He blew all our excuses out of the water and kept on asking us “What are you waiting for?”

He wants us to focus on our power, our divine power to make choices for our highest good and not to wait around for a Savior. It can be disconcerting for those of us who were taught that Jeshua is our savior and he will be coming to make everything right, to be confronted with the reality that we have to be our own saviors.

This chapter is so currently relevant! “Choose thou where you will be. Choose to know your divine nature, the Christ, to know good, happiness, appreciation of all the blessings in your life, and not to be down in the pit.” I like that he assures us that even if we fall into the pit occasionally, we have a “divine ladder to climb back up out of the pit.” That ladder is the “power of choice to follow the inner guidance.” And to “Cultivate the strength of patience.”

The power principles in Taking Action Now are:

- **Stop waiting for permission and give up excuses.**
- **Listen to your inner guidance.**
- **Make choices moment by moment for your divine nature.**
- **Cultivate the strength of patience.** Know that all is in **divine order.**
- **Be the Beholder.** Watch how everything does work together for the atonement. The realization of at-One-ment. Have

patience as you keep the vision alive.

- **Work on your positive attitude.**
- **Amp up the energy. Start putting aside the savings.**
- **Believe. Trust.**

Discussion Questions

- What passage in this chapter touches your heart? Your mind? Your imagination?
- Do you ever have the feeling that you are waiting for your “real” life to begin? For others to change so that you can feel positive about your life? What will it take for you to turn on the switch to stop waiting and act now.
- Jeshua tempers our impatience with reassurances that all is in **divine timing** and what may look like no progress, really is an evolutionary shift happening “you are all pulling the cart up the mountainside together, even though it may look like many are pulling it backwards.” How do you make that shift to a positive attitude, when outward appearances make it look like there is little reason to hope for positive outcomes? Have you practiced the art of being the Beholder? What choices can you make?

Affirmation for the Week:

Every vision, dream or idea that comes to me from the Father has a divine purpose. I give myself permission to act on it.

Assignments

- Ask yourself that question “What am I waiting for?” Is there anything in your life that you are not allowing yourself to have or experience? Perhaps you have outgrown a situation, a job or even friendships/relationships that are holding you back. Get really honest with yourself and listen to the guidance within, talk to a trusted friend and make a choice for more LIFE. Write about it in your journal.

- One of the Power Principles – **Patience is closely tied to Trust.**
“Sometimes what you are waiting for is the timing and one of the most difficult challenges is to have a vision, to want to get on with it, to know the creativity, to know you have the power to do it, and then to acquiesce to the higher self of timing and to be patient and to trust.”
Have you ever been in this “hallway” before the next door of opportunity opens? It can be a time of doubt and disillusion. How did you deal with it and how did it turn out. What did you tell yourself to keep your dream/desire/hope alive? Perhaps you are in one right now. If so, use the power principles and Jeshua’s words in this chapter to “make your waiting pleasant, awakened, happy, excited and trusting.”
Journal about the situation and the process and progress.
- Can you see the shift in the world that Jeshua is talking about on page 66? I certainly have seen the changes in my lifetime that there is more focus “upon respect for all living beings, more light upon issues that have been hidden, more courage to question old ways of thinking.”
What shifts have you seen towards the LIGHT in your lifetime? Perhaps you have been a part of them, like “Random Acts of Kindness”, more volunteering or involvement in your community and solving its challenges. Think about how your corner of the world has been making shifts towards positive evolution. How can you continue to be a part of these shifts “to be the savior” in even simple situations? Record them in your journal and be on the lookout for them from now on.
- Jeshua gives us a unique view of the purpose of our families of origin. That is to “sandpaper” and “polish” us, which can be on the painful side. But apparently we chose them for that purpose. (page 65) In this light, can you reframe the relationships with your family members who did that “for” you? Perhaps now that you know the bigger picture, it may be time to forgive them and thank them instead. How does that feel? Process that possibility however feels right for you at this time.
